A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the creation and establishment of the Lelu Trading Center and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE 12TH LELU TOWN COUNCIL

- 1 **Section 1: Short Title:** This Act is known and shall be cited as the Lelu Trading Center
2 Act of 2022.
- 3 **Section 2: Statement of Purpose:** It is the purpose of the Lelu Town Council to provide for the
4 people of Lelu a trading center to promote the farming and fishing industry and to create for the
5 people alternative income streams through farming, fishing, wood-carving, crafting, and other
6 local trading skills
- 7 **Section 3: Establishment:** There is hereby established the Lelu Trading Center as a practical
8 vehicle for promoting self-reliance and connecting people towards the attainment of economic
9 development and social integrity. The LTG shall encourage the Lelu Farmers and Fishing
10 Corporation to undertake the actual formation and organization of the Lelu Trading Center and
11 shall create an atmosphere that is conducive to the growth and development of the market.
- 12 **Section 4: Creation, Composition, Supervision:** There shall be a Board of Directors to be known
13 as the Lelu Farmers and Fishing Corporation (LFFC) consisting of five (5) board members
14 appointed amongst and by the fourteen (14) members of the Lelu Farmers Cooperative
15 Association and the Lelu Fishing Cooperative Association. The Board of Directors shall be

16 consisting of a Chairman, a Vice Chairman, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and a Secretary Treasurer.

17 Neither associations shall hold no more than 3 seats in the LFFC Board of Directors.

18 **Section 5: Functions:** The Lelu Farmers and Fishing Corporation shall function in accordance
19 with the terms and conditions set forth in the Lelu Trading Center Memorandum of Agreement
20 (MOA), and in harmony with the laws and ordinances of the state and local government
21 altogether.

22 **Section 6: Holding Over:** A member of the Board of Director holds office beyond his/her term
23 until such time that a successor takes office.


24 **Section 7: Vacancy.** In the event a vacancy occurs in a membership of the Board of Directors by
25 the members: *means of the following.*

- 26 1) Submission of a written resignation to the body's presiding officers and the Mayor.
- 27 2) Death
- 28 3) Incapacitating illness
- 29 4) Absences from three consecutive governing body meetings.
- 30 5) Continuous absence from the municipality or the state for a period of six months.
- 31 6) Removed by the Council for malfeasance in the office. The process for filling a
32 vacancy is pursuant to Section 4 of this Act.

33 **Section 8: Effective Date:** This Act shall become law upon the signature of the Mayor or upon
34 its becoming law without such signature.
